

Go Kit (Aluminum Case)

Base Station Radio:

1. Yaesu FT-1900, 5-10-25-50- watt 2 meter mobil radio
2. SEC 1223 110/12 volt 100 watt power supply
3. 9 ampere hour, 12 volt battery power supply, with 110 volt AC charger
4. Cigarette lighter socket, female, with red and black battery post clips
5. Cigarette lighter plug, male (screw type)
6. Cigarette lighter plug adapter, male, with 2 female sockets
7. JVC headset (folds flat)
8. Mag mount 2 meter 70 centimeter antenna
9. 30"x 12" piece of aluminum foil (acts as ground plan for mag mount)
10. 20' of RG-58U coax extension cable, with coax cable coupling

Handheld Radio:

1. Yaesu VX-170 handheld radio with belt clip
2. Hot Rod antenna
3. Yaesu VX-170 110 volt battery charger
